December Recap

Council Update

We had two City Council meetings last month. Here are some of the highlights from those meetings. We approved a motion to direct staff to prepare the necessary actions to ban all new, non-hosted STRs in all residential districts in the City except for the Residential Tourist Zoning District. We approved Deputy Mayor Keim's appointments to regional boards and commissions with the change of making myself the primary appointment to the North County Transit District with Councilmember Joyce as alternate. We also approved a motion to direct staff to change the inclusionary housing requirement citywide to 15 percent and approve all other aspects of the previously introduced changes to Chapter 14C. Additionally, we approved the adoption of a resolution setting new slip rental rate fees in the Oceanside Harbor.

Our next Council Meeting will be held on January 10th at 5:00pm.
